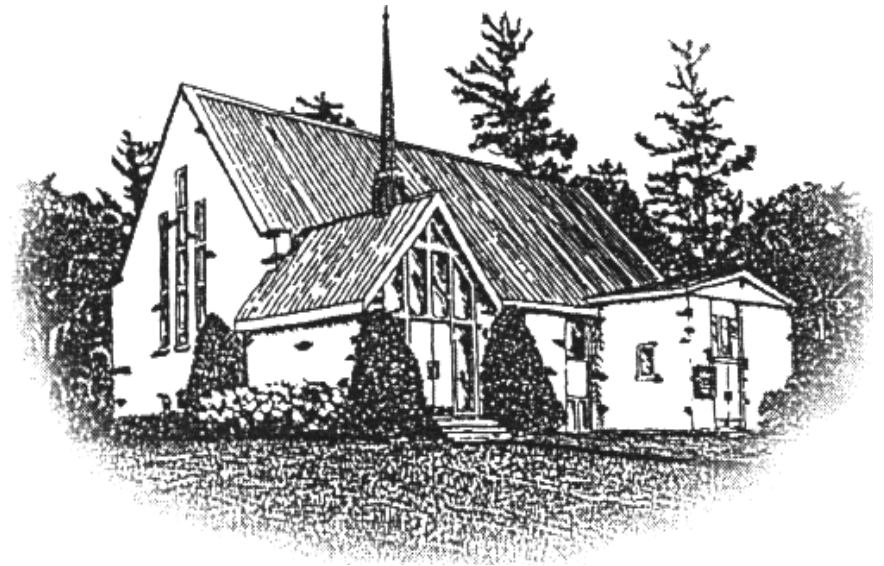
Gratitude shouldn't be an occasional incident but a continuous attitude.
