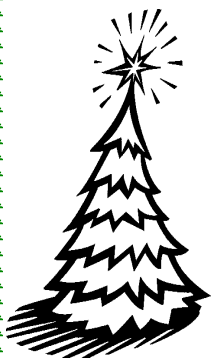


PLEASE HELP DECORATE OUR CHRISTMAS TREE
