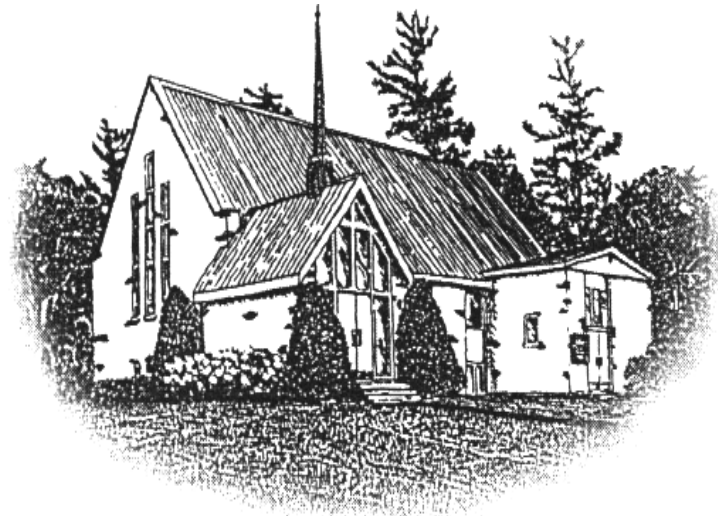
Someone will be calling soon to round up our very willing volunteers.
