

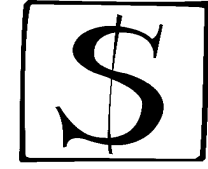
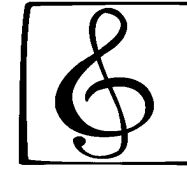
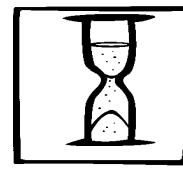
Invitation to join

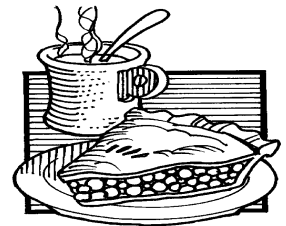
