We host a combined service with Stittsville United Church. A simple Tenebrae service of readings meditations communion and extinguishing of candles.

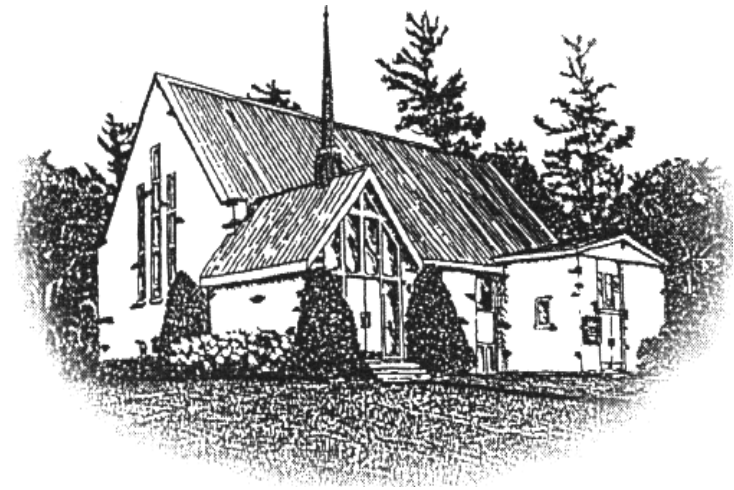
Good Friday - April 2, 10:00 a.m.
