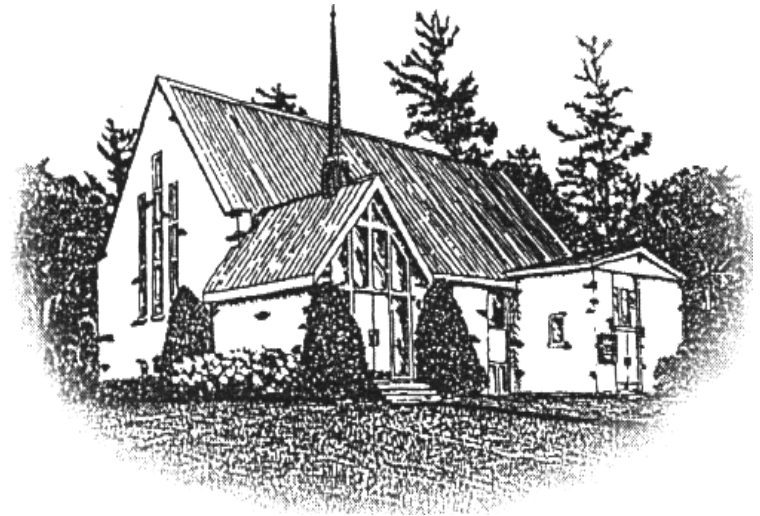

Stittsville Food Bank Sunday
