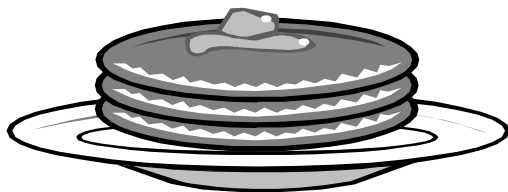

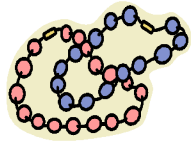

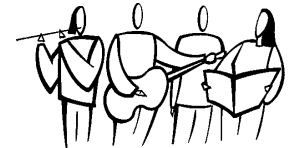


COFFEE HOUSE
