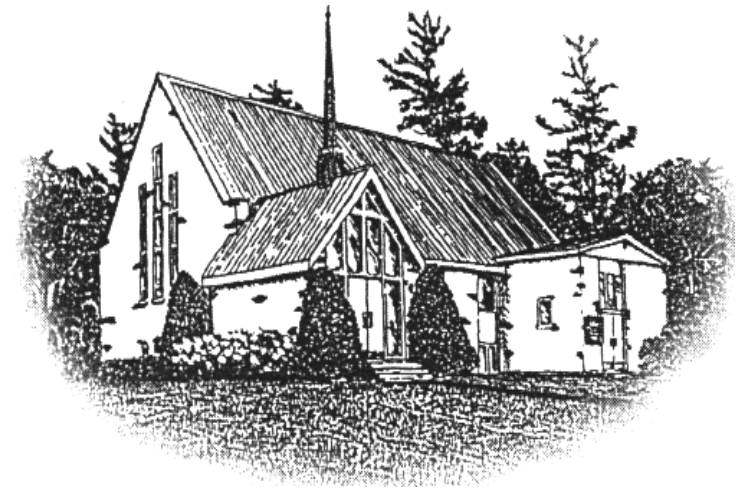

Where is our minister this morning?

Doug is one of six members of the Presbytery of Ottawa who are at something called the Emmaus Project. The Emmaus Project brings 145 people together from 17 different presbyteries across the country. We will also have three leaders for the workshop, three of the leading minds in church renewal in North America today. The purpose of the conference is to work with presbyteries to fine tune where we may make significant changes, but it will also impact what we do as a congregation and with our own Session. This Emmaus Project marks the culmination of a three process emerging from the Long Range Planning committee of our national church as a follow up to the Flames and Sabbath year initiatives. Our national church went through a very long strategic planning strategy and when it was finished they decided that the best way to transform the institution of the Presbyterian Church in Canada was to work through the basic building blocks which are the presbyteries. The decision was not to do new programs but rather develop a strategic plan. Each selected presbytery sends a critical mass 5-10 representatives depending upon the size of the presbytery, sufficient to effect change within their own framework. Please keep us in your prayers
