Sly raccoon and the turtle dove.

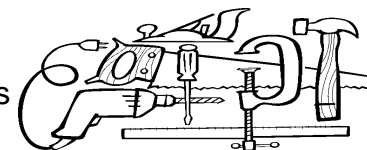

ance parking lot, Main St, Stittsville.



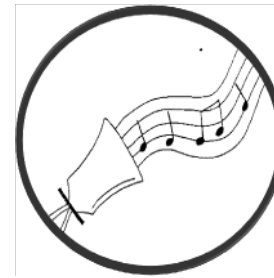
