DID YOU KNOW

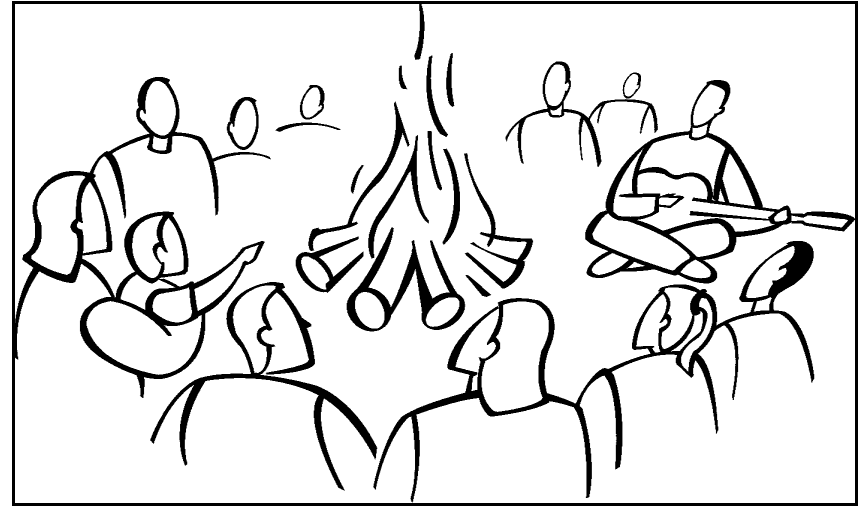
