CEMETERY SERVICE

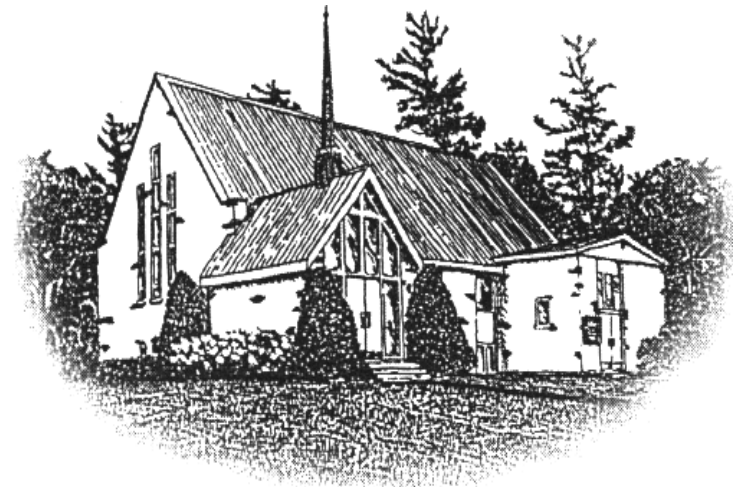
