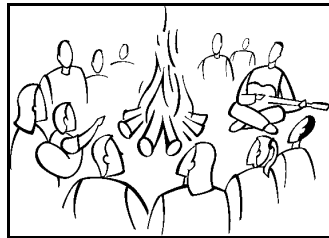

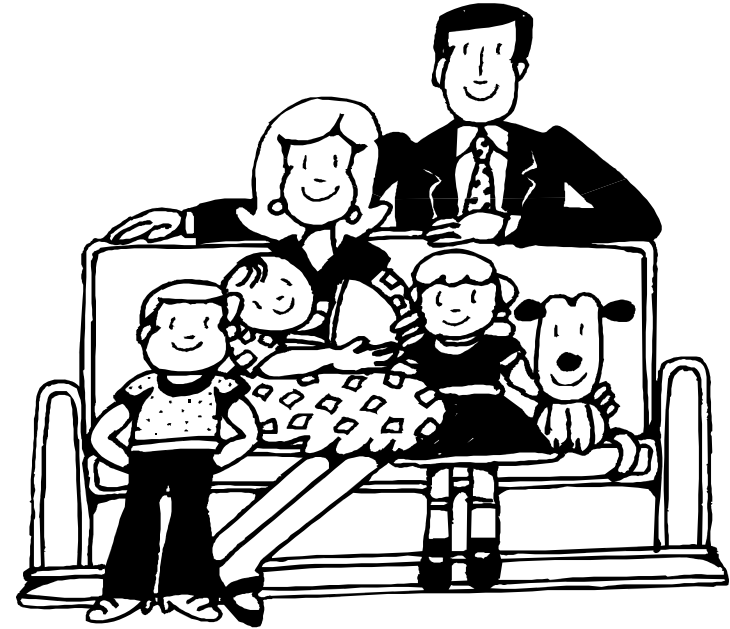
Camping Sunday:
