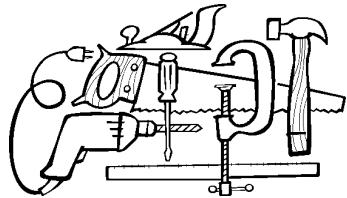

Saturday, October 23rd has been set aside for our fall Arbour Day to get our church ready for the winter months. The Board of Manager is asking for help from

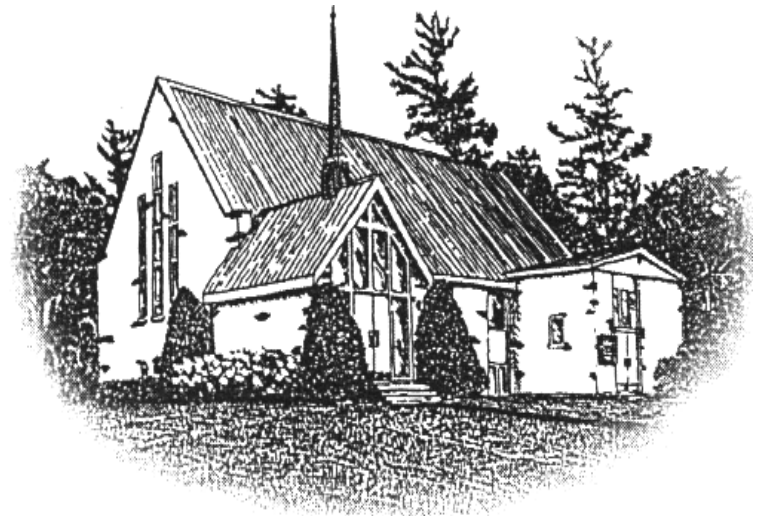
the congregation to do a few jobs both inside and outside the building starting at 9:00 am.
