CANADA: Companions for the journey

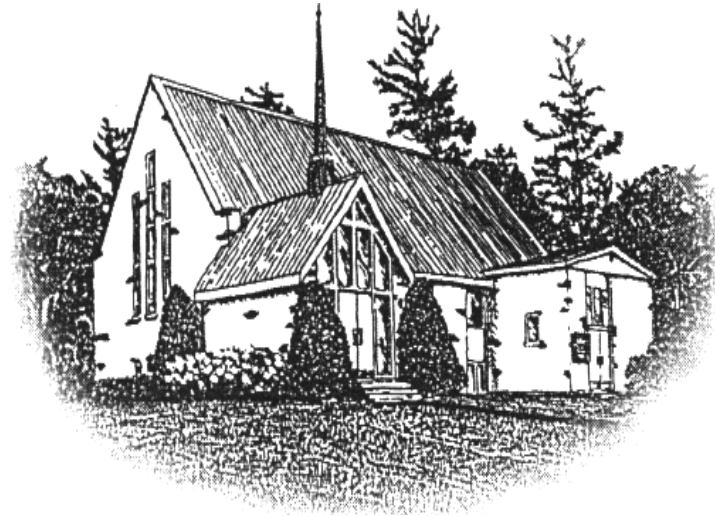
