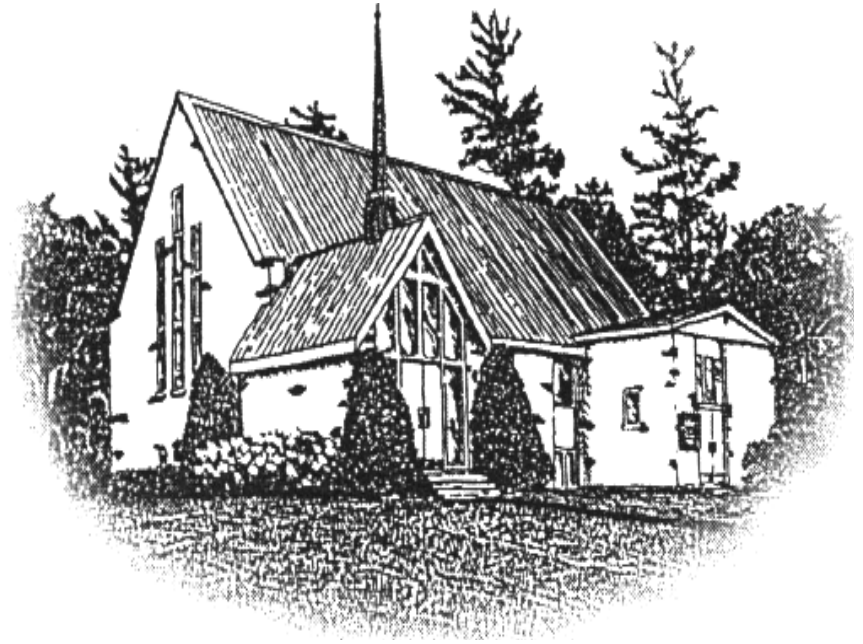


Room to Doodle
