THINGS WE COLLECT IN MISSION

Pop tabs - Proceeds from pop tab collections are used to benefit March of Dimes Assistive Devices Program.

Used Eyeglasses - They are taken to Dr. Motluk's office where they get sent off to Third World Countries.

Canadian Tire money - This gets used to buy supplies, ie custodial, kitchen products etc.

THINGS WE COLLECT IN MISSION

Milk bags (the outer ones) - To help the environment by recycling plastic milk bags. Did you know that it takes about 15 years for these bags to break down in our landfills? Why not repurpose the bags as a durable and long lasting sleeping mat? With scissors, crochet hook and willing hands, they are transformed into these washable, quick-dry bed mats which provide an alternative to sleeping on the damp, hard ground. Medical teams in Haiti found them invaluable.
